

Starting Trial of iSpring Presenter

You can start using the trial version of iSpring Suite right away after installation. The trial version of iSpring Suite is the best way to evaluate all features of the product. This fully functional version produces content of the same quality as the full version. You can use the trial for 14 days. After the trial period is over, you will need to activate the product with the license key, received after the purchase.

The Trial Version Limitations

The only limitations of the trial version are a 14-day limit and an evaluation banner covering a part of the presentation area as you can see in the picture below.
