

# Adjusting Slide Duration

You can set timing for automatic slide advance in the field to the right of the slide advance type. It's also possible to specify duration for a selected group of slides in the corresponding text field on the toolbar.

Time formatting works similar to PowerPoint.

**Note:** Slide advance time also depends on "Minimal slide duration" that can be specified on the [Playback and Navigation](#) tab of the Publish window.
