# **Getting Permissions of a Content Item**

You can get permissions of a content item by sending the GET request to the following URL: /content/<content\_item\_id>/permissions.

Permission to run the request: Account Owner, Administrator, Organization Administrator, Publisher.

### Request Headers

| Parameter                     | Description   |
|-------------------------------|---|
| X-Auth-Account-Url (required) | Base URL of the account, e.g. http://myaccount.ispringlearn.com |
| X-Auth-Email (required)       | Administrator/Publisher e-mail address.                         |
| X-Auth-Password (required)    | Administrator/Publisher password.                               |

After the request has been completed, the system returns the response with Code 200. The body of the response will contain xml data with security settings of a given content item.

## Possible Response Codes

| С   | ode | Text | Description                                  |
|-----|-----|------|--|
| 200 | 0   | Ok   | The request has been processed successfully. |
