

Getting Permissions of a Content Item

You can get permissions of a content item by sending the GET request to the following URL: **/content/<content_item_id>/permissions**.

Permission to run the request: Account Owner, Administrator, Organization Administrator, Publisher.

Request Headers

Parameter	Description
X-Auth-Account-Url (required)	Base URL of the account, e.g. http://myaccount.ispringlearn.com
X-Auth-Email (required)	Administrator/Publisher e-mail address.
X-Auth-Password (required)	Administrator/Publisher password.

After the request has been completed, the system returns the response with Code 200. The body of the response will contain xml data with security settings of a given content item.

Possible Response Codes

Code	Text	Description
200	Ok	The request has been processed successfully.
