

Getting Group Information

You can get information about a group with the **getGroupInformation** method.

Permission to run the request: Account Owner, Administrator, Organization Administrator, Publisher.

Parameters

Parameter	Type	Description
credentials (required)	credentials	Read the description of the Credentials object.
groupId (required)	string	ID of the group you want to get information of.

Return Value

After the request has been completed, the system returns an object with the following properties:

Parameter	Type	Description
groupId	string	ID of the group.
name	string	Name of the group.
description	string	Description of the group.
users	string[]	An array with IDs of the users who belong to the group.
organizationId	int	ID of the organization.

Possible Errors

Error	Description
Unknown group	The group was not found or the user doesn't have enough permissions to get info on the group (for example, organization administrators and publishers can't get info on the group if it is not within their organization).
