

# Linking Questions

Linking questions is essentially useful when you want to randomize questions while keeping some questions together. For instance, if you want a practice question always go after a certain theory question, you can link them to be presented in this order.

A question position can also be locked within a group. You can attach a question to the beginning or the end of a question group.

To link a question:

1. Click a question in the Question List to select it
2. Click the **Link** button on the toolbar to open the menu
3. Select one of the available choices:

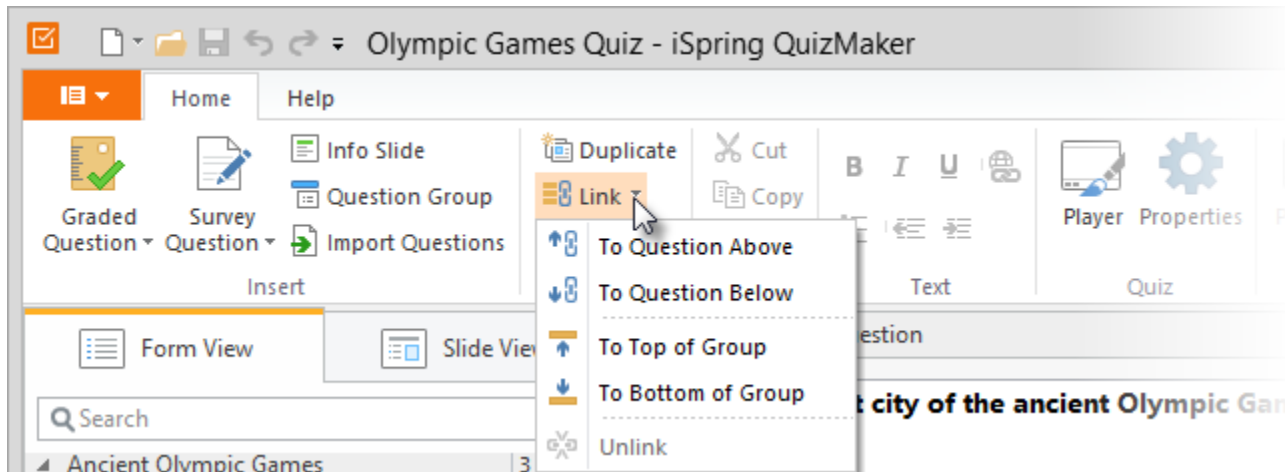
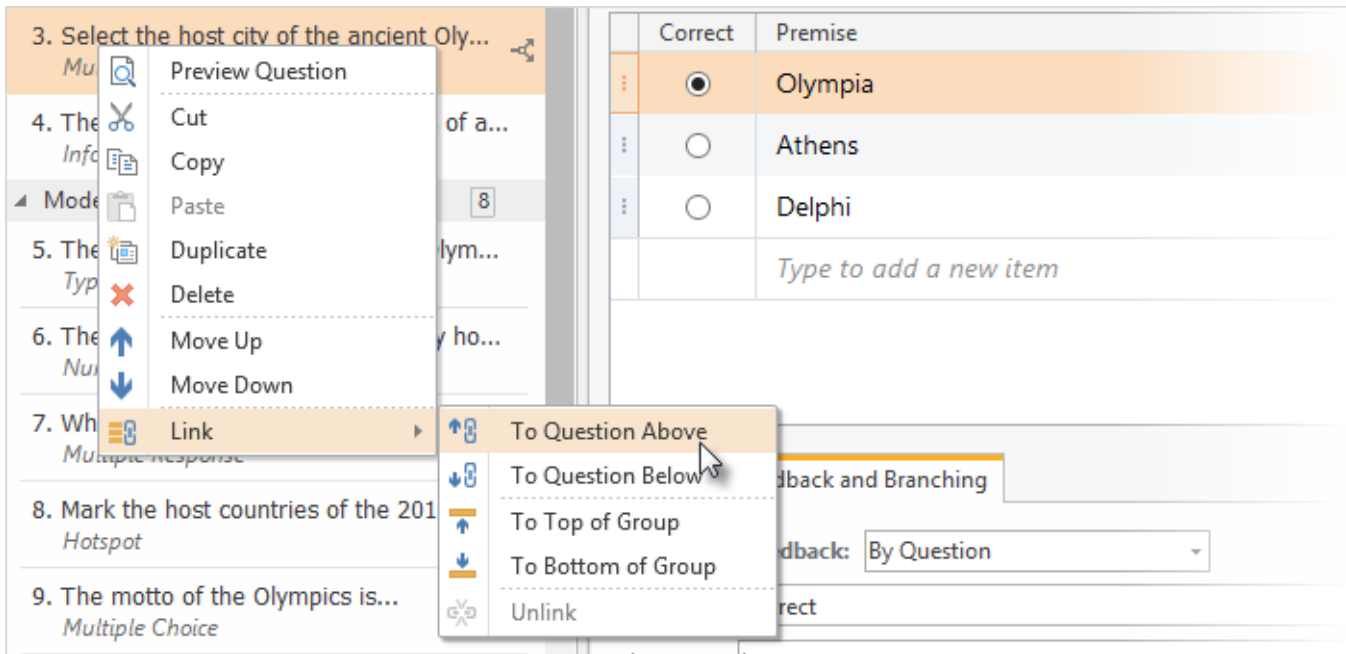


Table 1. Linking Options

| Option                    | Description  |
|---------------------------|--|
| <b>To Question Above</b>  | The question will always be asked after the question which is currently shown above it.  |
| <b>To Question Below</b>  | The question will always be displayed before the question which is currently below it.   |
| <b>Selected Questions</b> | A group of the selected questions will be linked together and displayed together in the fixed order in a quiz.                     |
| <b>To Top of Group</b>    | The selected question will be displayed as the first one in the group. Only one question can be linked to the top of each group.   |
| <b>To Bottom of Group</b> | The selected question will be displayed as the last one in the group. Only one question can be linked to the bottom of each group. |

or

Right-click a question in the list and choose **Link** from the drop-down menu.



**Note:** It's also possible to link several questions. Just select them in the list using the Shift or Ctrl buttons and then choose **Selected Questions** in the Link menu.

To remove all linking settings applied earlier, select a linked question or several questions and choose **Unlink** in the Link menu.
