

# Removing User from a Group

You can remove a user from a group with the `removeUserFromGroup` method.

Permission to run the request: Account Owner, Administrator, Organization Administrator.

## Parameters

Parameter	Type	Description
credentials (required)	credentials	Read the description of the <a href="#">Credentials</a> object.
groupId (required)	string	ID of the group you want to delete the specified user from.
userId (required)	string	ID of the user you want to delete from the specified group.

## Return Value

After the request has been completed, the system returns an object with the following properties:

Parameter	Type	Description
success	bool	'True' if the given user has been removed from the group.

## Possible Error

Text	Description
Unknown user	The specified user hasn't been found.
Unknown group	The specified group hasn't been found.
Permission Denied	You don't have permissions to edit the specified group info.
User not a group's member	A given user does not belong to the specified group.
Wrong parameters	The system failed to process the request because it did not contain all necessary parameters.
