

Randomizing Questions in a Group

The actual version of your test presented to a quiz taker can include:

- all questions from a group in a fixed order
- all questions from a group in a random order
- a limited number of questions randomly selected from a group

To set question randomizing:

1. Select a question group

2. Select between two options:

- Include all questions from the group
- Select random questions

Option	Description

Note: Info slides are not counted when randomizing questions. If a group contains branched questions, randomizing may interfere with the branching settings.
