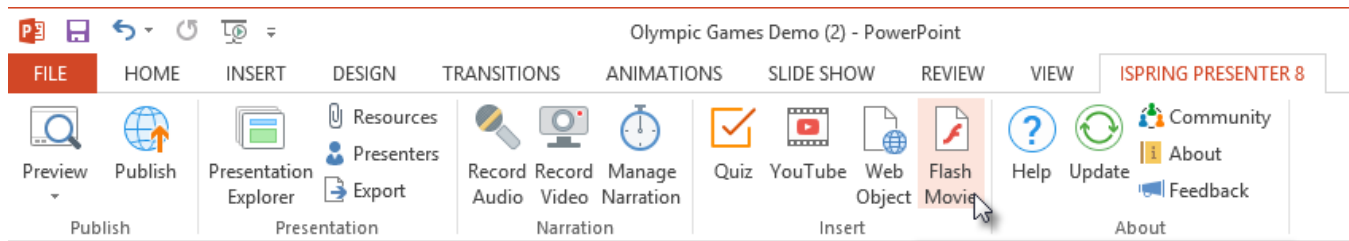


Inserting Flash Movies

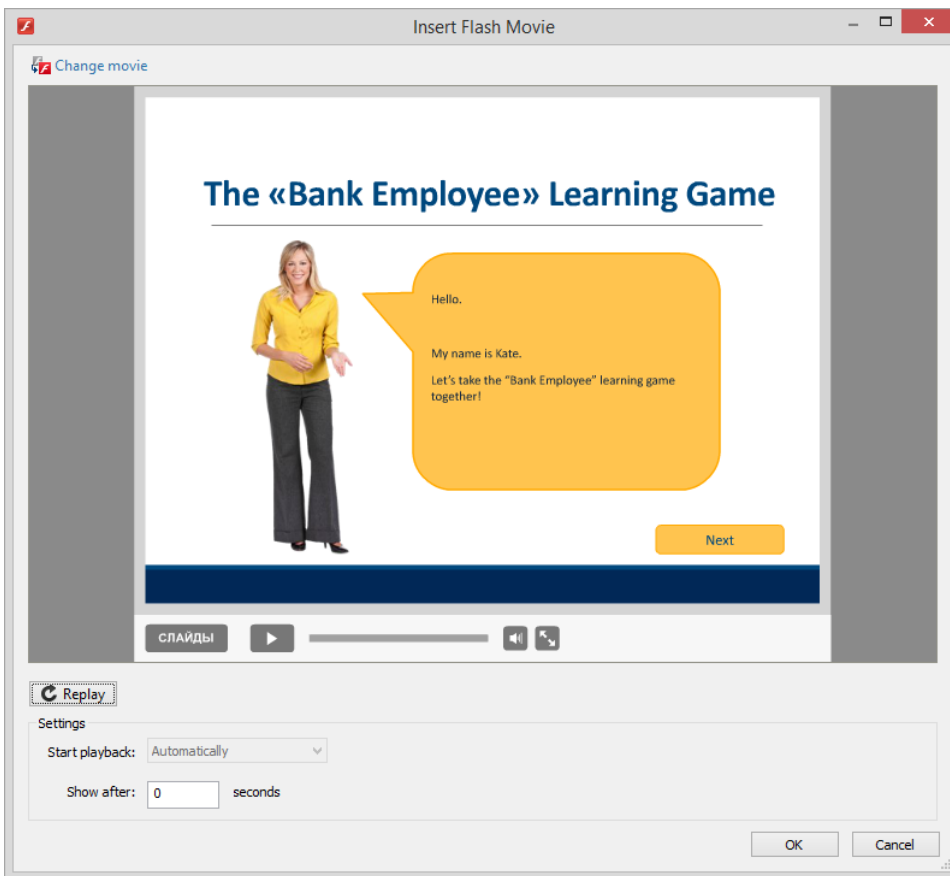
The **Insert Flash** feature allows you to easily insert external Flash movies into your PowerPoint slides.

You can import **.swf** or **.flv** files to the slide.



To insert a Flash movie, follow these steps:

1. Click the **Flash Movie** button on the iSpring toolbar.
2. Choose a Flash file to be inserted into the presentation and click **Open**.
3. Preview and edit the selected Flash file in the **Insert Flash Movie** window. For more details, see [Flash Movie Options](#) below.
4. Click **OK** to add your Flash Movie to the slide.



You will see the first frame of an **.swf** file or a static placeholder if you added an **.flv** file. The inserted Flash movie can be easily resized and moved within the slide.

| Settings | Description |
|-----------------------|---|
| Change movie | This option allows you to navigate to your Flash file and replace the existing one. |
| Start playback | This options allows you to set the Flash Movie to play automatically or on a mouse click. |
| Show after | This option allows you to specify when your Flash Movie will appear on a slide. The default delay is 0 seconds, which means that a Flash Movie appears immediately. |
