Specify the time period for the events — **Month** or **Week**. To view all upcoming events, select **List**.

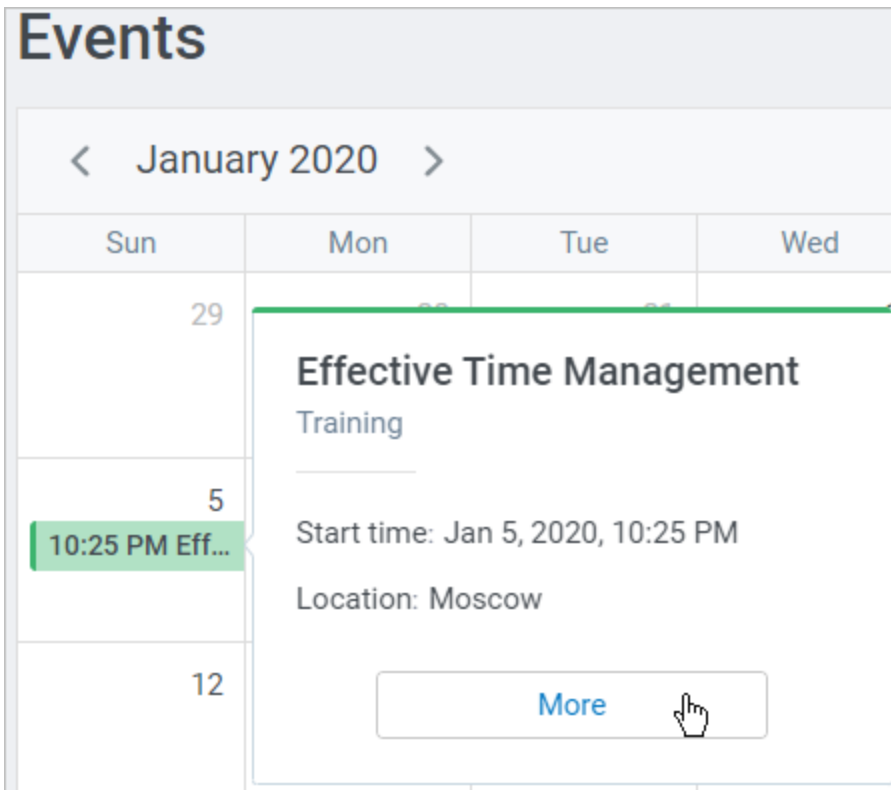

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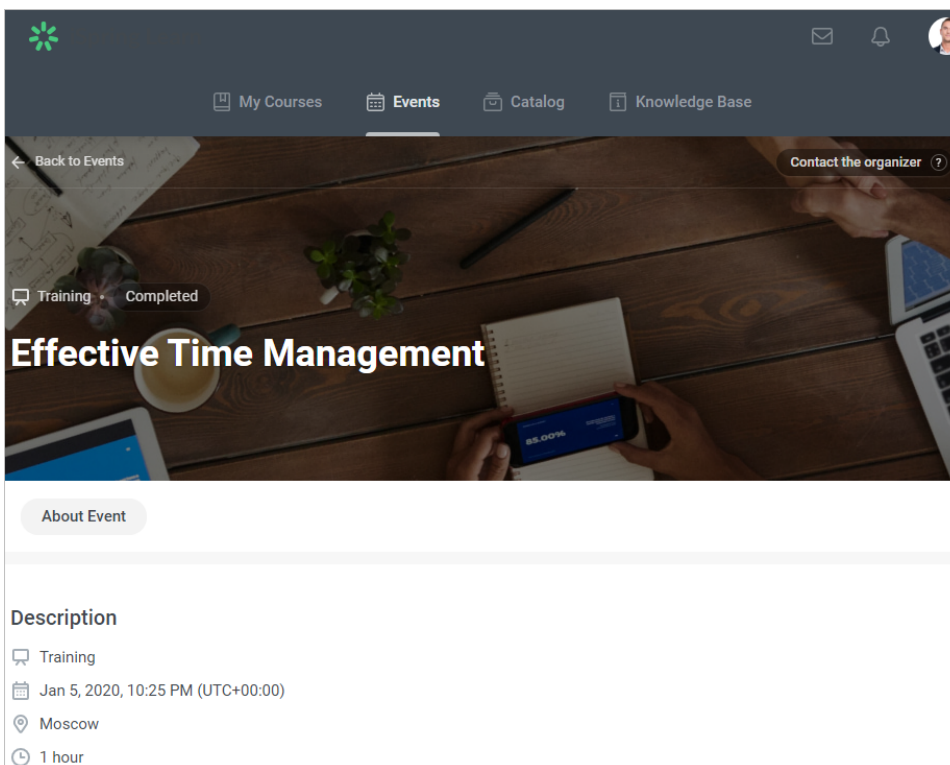
## Viewing an Event
