

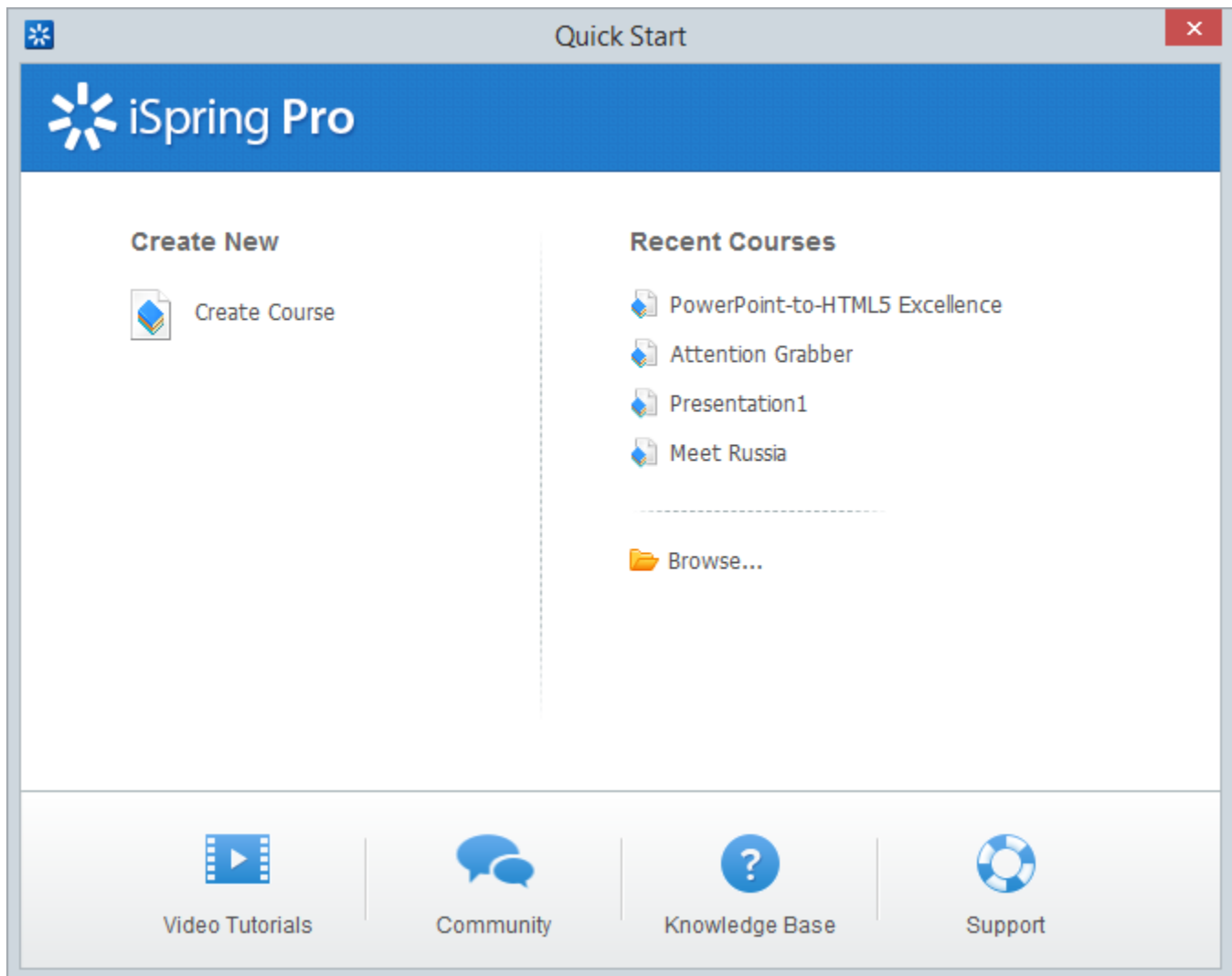
Getting Started with iSpring Pro

With iSpring Pro you can easily create mobile-ready video courses and interactive presentations right in PowerPoint.

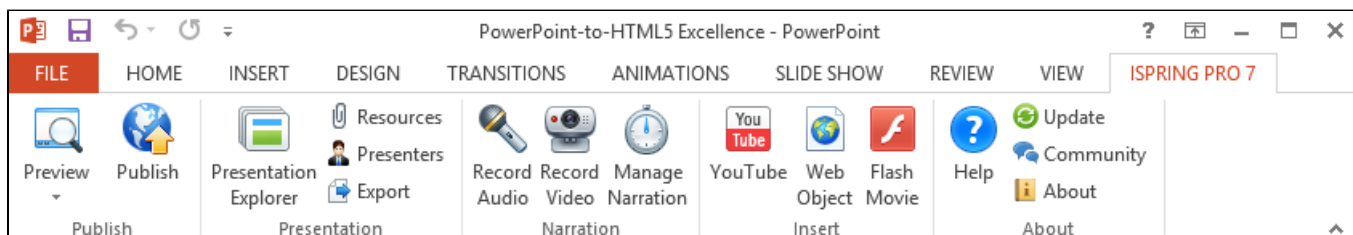

As you start iSpring Pro, you will see a Quick Start screen, which gives you access to the basic operations with the product. From this window, you can create a new presentation, open from the list of recent presentations, or choose to browse media resources related to iSpring Pro.



iSpring Pro is a PowerPoint add-in, and it appears as an additional tab on the PowerPoint ribbon.
