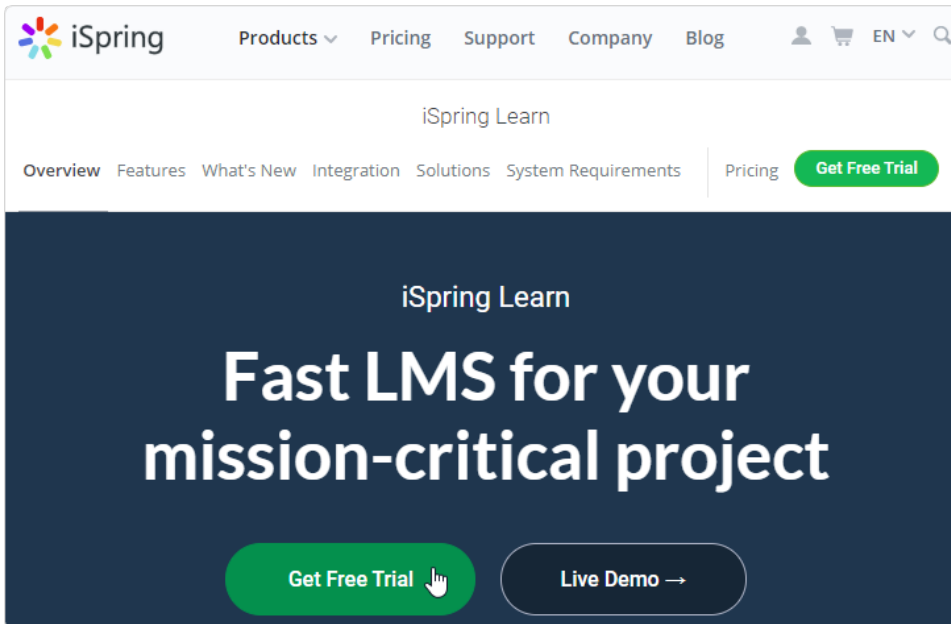


Try iSpring Learn

To get your iSpring Learn trial account:


1. Click **Get Free Trial** on the [iSpring Learn](#) page.



2. Enter your email address, name, and phone number and click **Start Free Trial**.

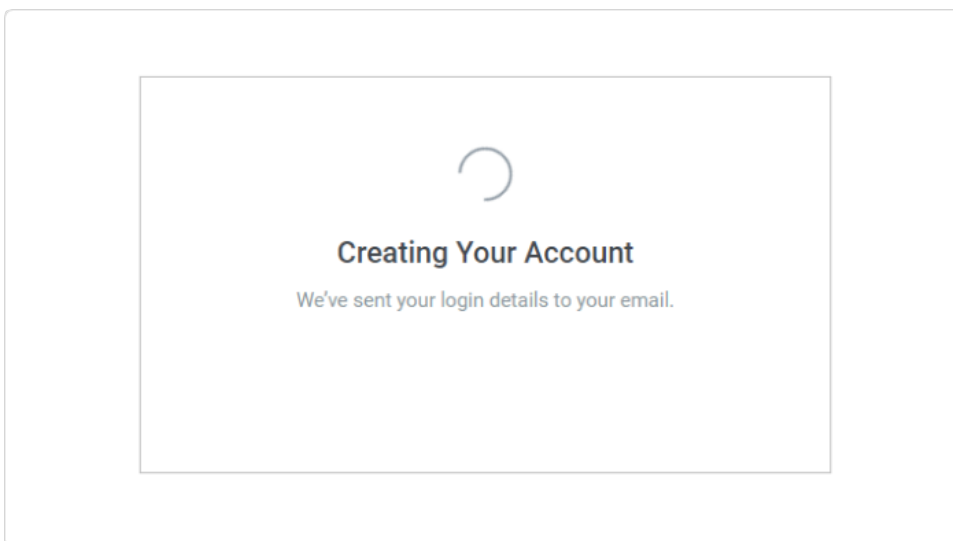

 - b. The site URL is created automatically based on the team's title. If the title was registered before, a random number will be added to the link, for example, [myteam-12.ispringlearn.com](#).

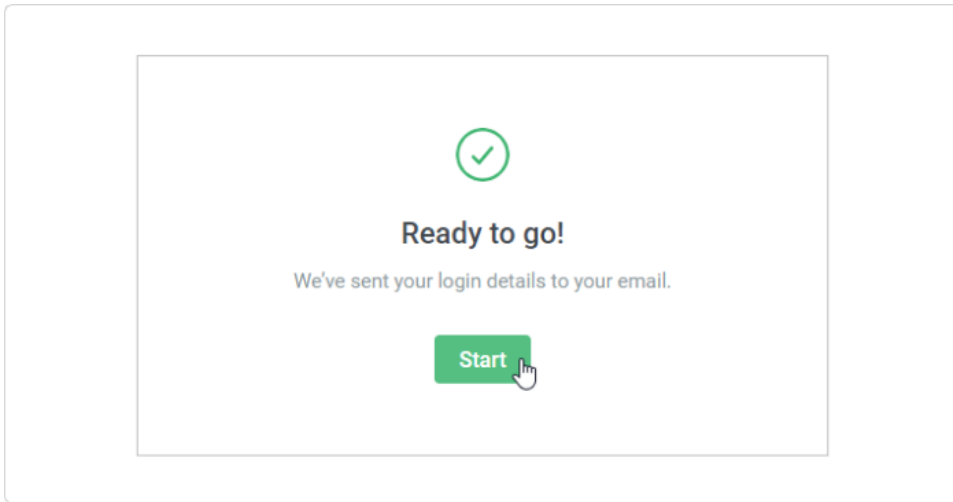
