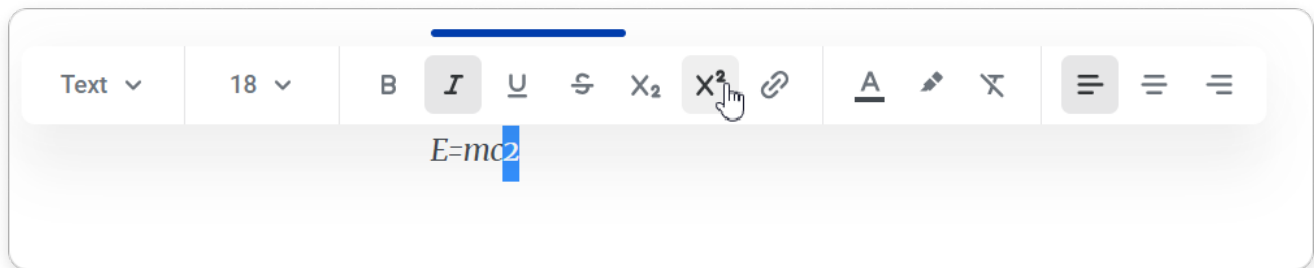


Text Formatting

In pages, you can format text. For example, underline a word or change the font size.

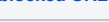
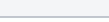
Highlight the text you want to change. Then, click on the desired option in the toolbar that appears.
