

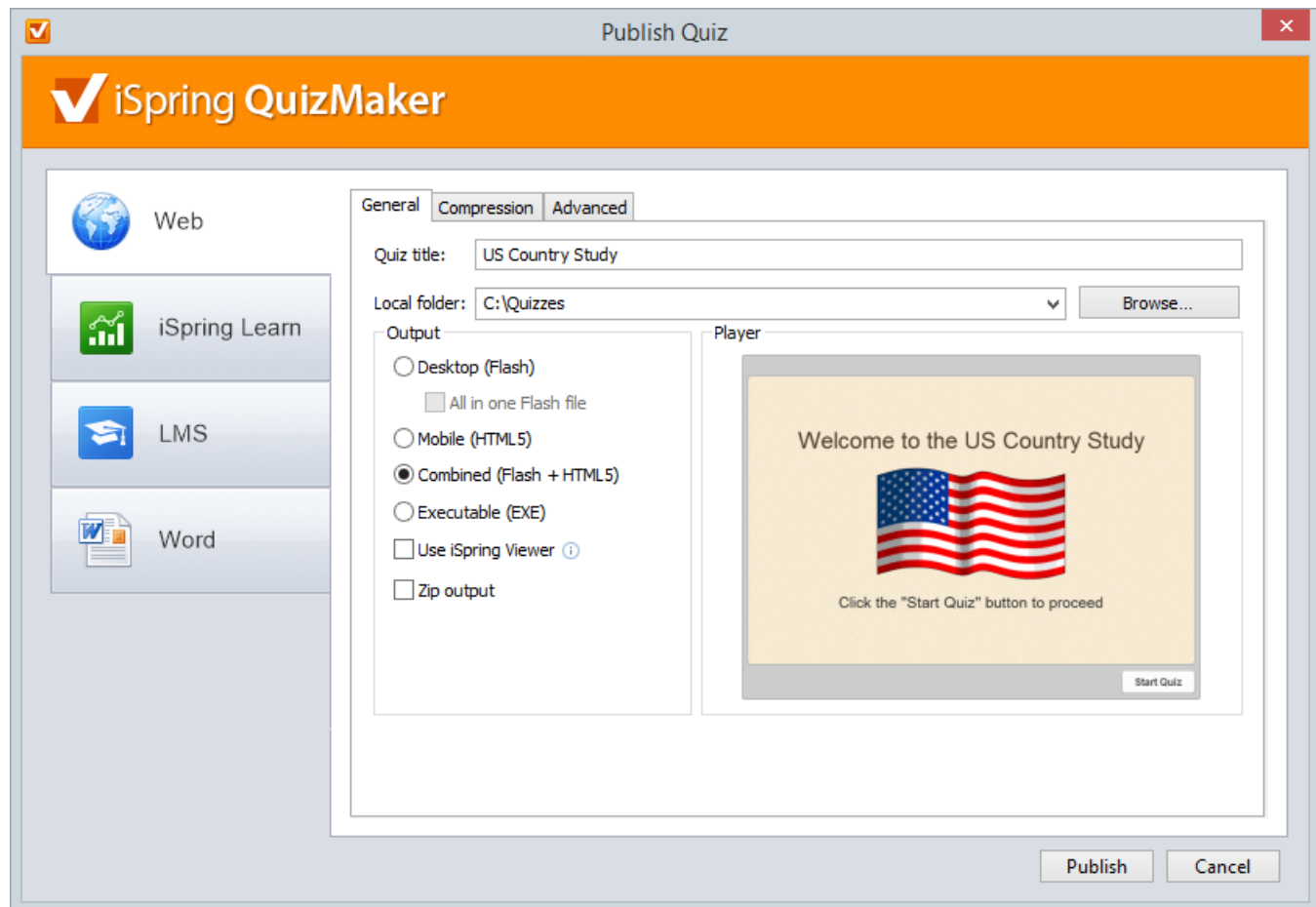
# What's New in iSpring QuizMaker 7

iSpring QuizMaker 7 is a new major release introducing lots of new features.

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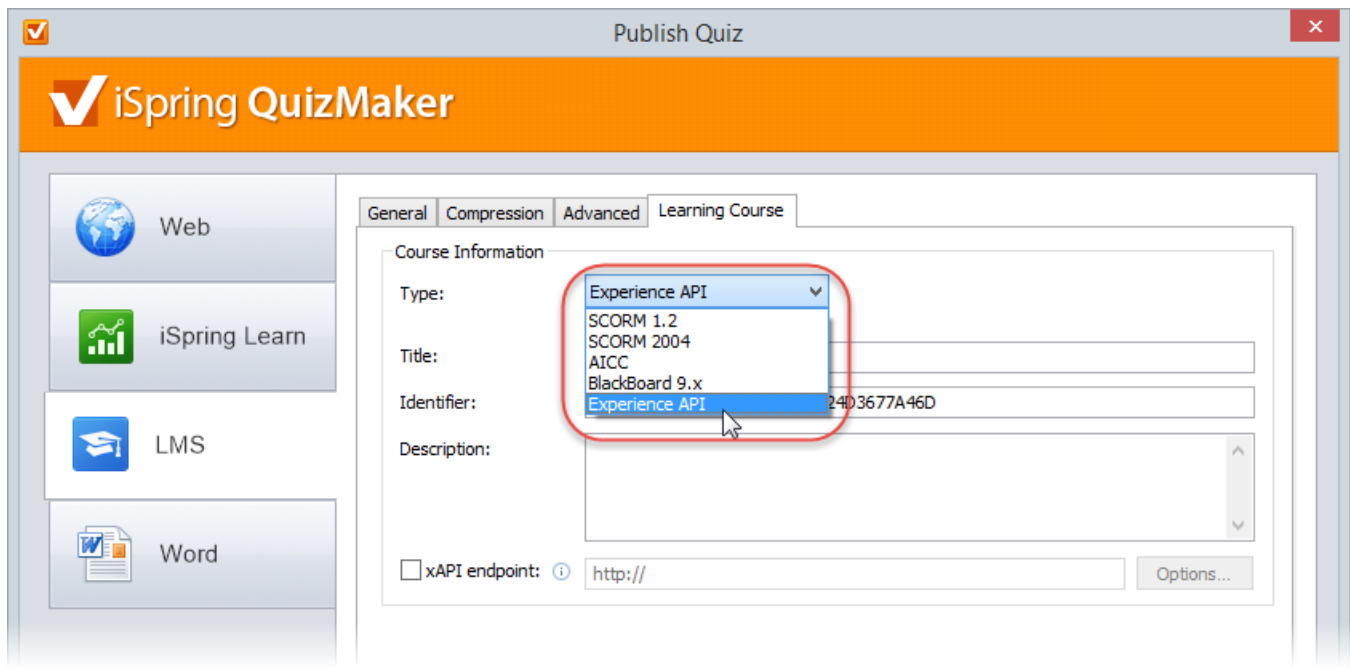
## Publishing to HTML5 and Combined Mode

iSpring QuizMaker 7 allows you to build quizzes in Flash, HTML5 or in the Combined mode (Flash + HTML5). Now, you can create quizzes that will be supported across multiple devices: computers, tablets and smartphones.



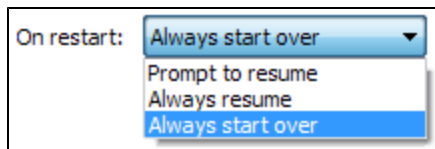
## Experience API Support

Publish quizzes that support Experience API to get more information and feedback from your eLearning materials. iSpring gives you the chance to take all advantages of the emerging xAPI learning technology.



## Save/Recover State of a Quiz

Thanks to extended functionality of the "Resume" option, you can start taking the quiz on one device and continue completing the quiz on another one, with progress saved.



## Updated Quiz Editor

iSpring's quiz editor has been updated to provide more flexible and user-friendly quiz authoring. The new interface remains very easy to learn and use, while offering many new features.

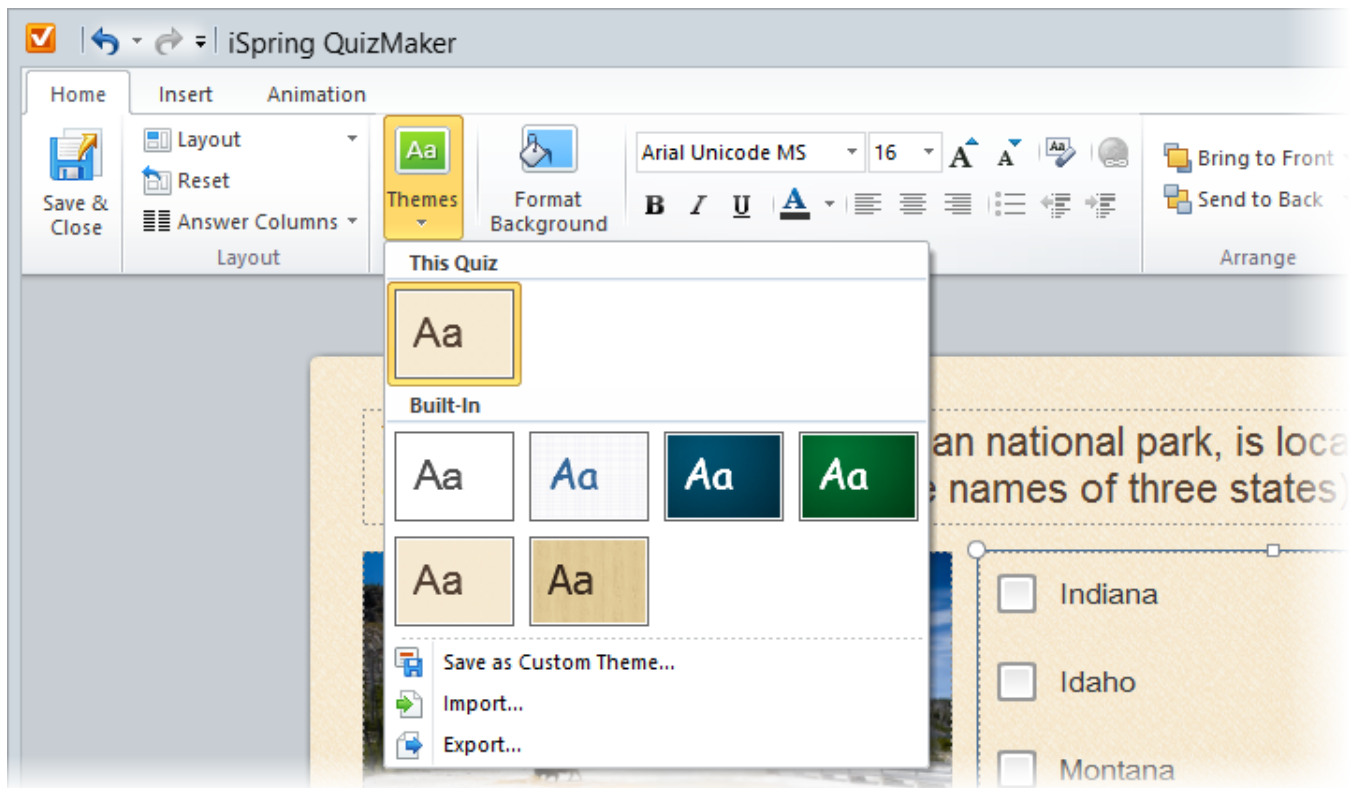
## Designing Quiz Layout

Now it's up to you where quiz elements – questions, images, answer choices – are located. Be creative!

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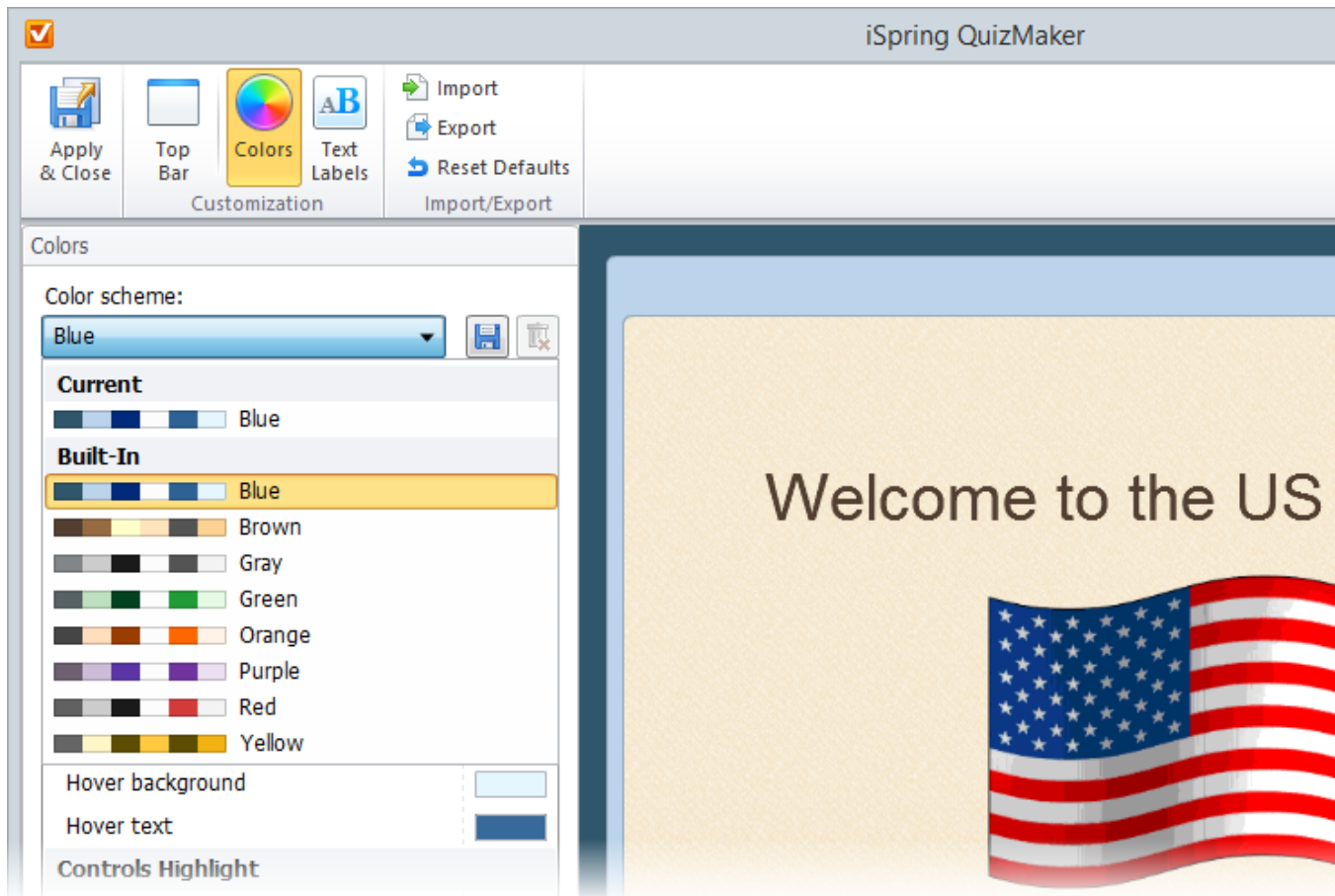
## Building Custom Themes

## Questions Linking

You can better control quizzes' playback by linking questions together or attaching them to the beginning or the end of your quiz.

## Locking Answer Choice Position

You can randomize the answers in the Multiple Choice or Multiple Response question still having certain answer options locked in their position. It is useful when one of the choice is 'Other' or "No Answer" that is usually added at the end of the list.

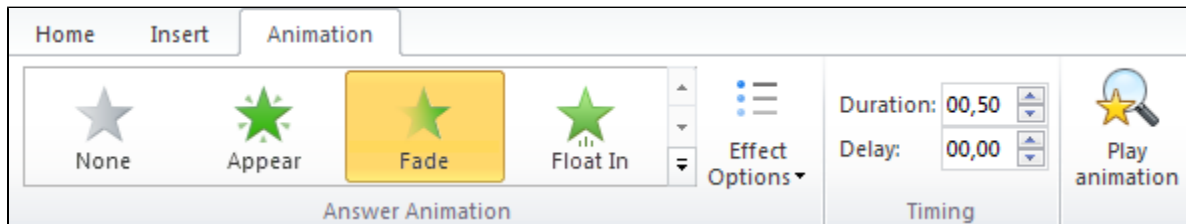
## Questions Import from Excel

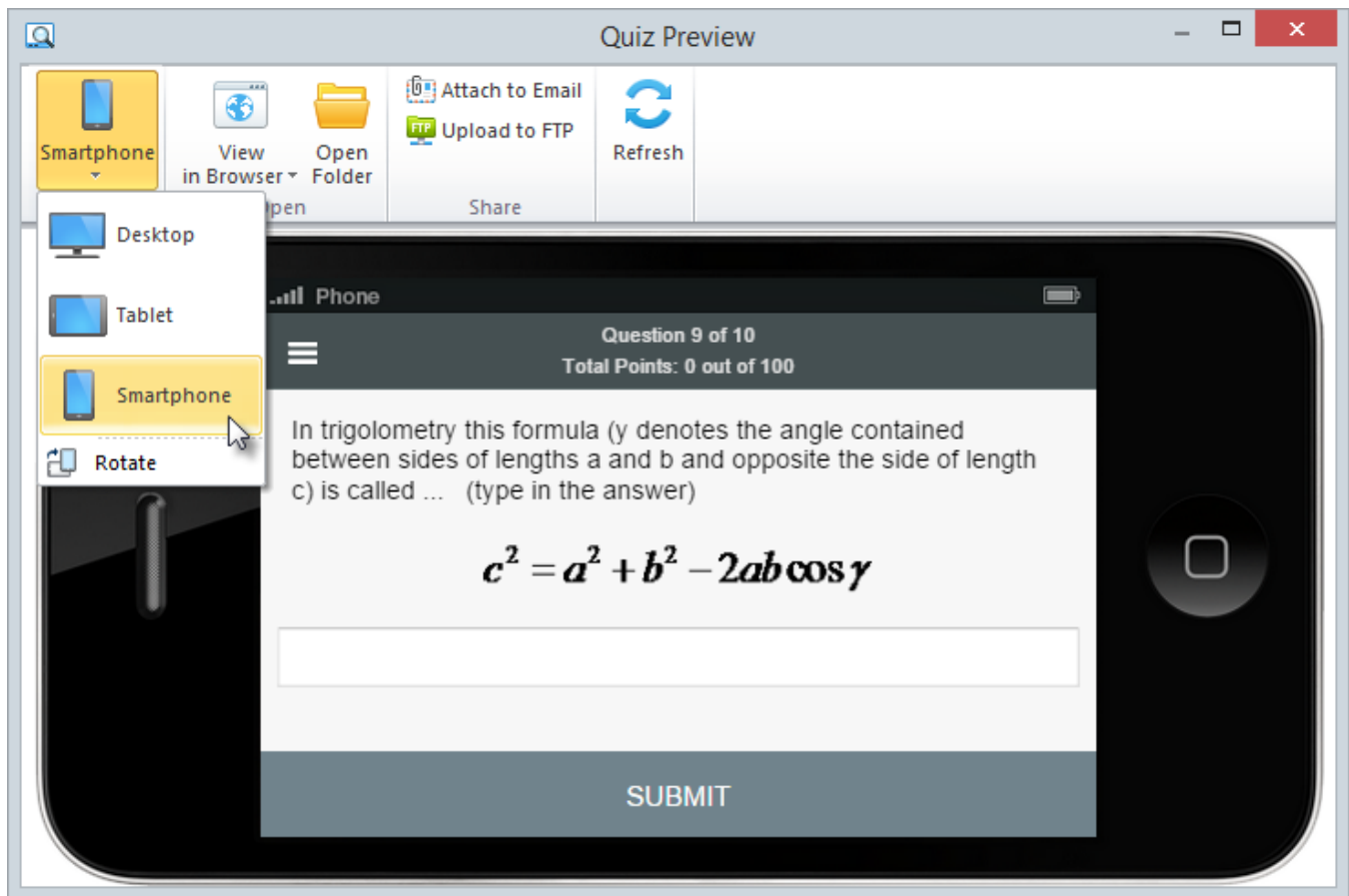
## Spelling
