Embed Code


The second way to add a video to an article is by inserting an embed code.

Embed code is generated by a third-party website such as YouTube. Users can embed multimedia elements, such as YouTube videos, into their site. Let's see how to copy embed code from a YouTube video:


1. Locate a video on YouTube and click Share.




2. In the opened window, click Embed.



3. Next, click Copy. The embed code is copied and you can now insert it into your page.




1. opy the embed video code on YouTube or another portal, then, click , and choose Embed




2. Next, insert an embed link or iframe code and press Enter on the keyboard.




3. The clip will be added to the page.
