

Locking the Player Controls

You can restrict user navigation by disabling the player navigation controls. If you lock them, navigation will be disabled in the following areas:

- Outline
- Thumbnails
- Timeline
- Previous/Next
- Replay

In player, when your mouse pointer is over the Outline or navigation buttons, you will see the lock icon on them. Users won't be able to move to the locked slide.

Note: Even if navigation is locked, users can navigate to another slide on click or automatically. Disable [Automatic](#) or [On-Click navigation](#), if you want to completely restrict user navigation.
