

# Adding Interactions

iSpring's Presentation Explorer allows you to insert interactions into PowerPoint slides using the Object column.

To add an interaction to a particular slide:

1. Click the **Add** button in the **Object** column.
2. Select one of the options from the drop-down menu:
  - **Create New Interaction** - Select this option to create a new interaction in the iSpring Visuals editor
  - **Import from File** - This option allows you to select one of the existing interactions to insert into the slide.
