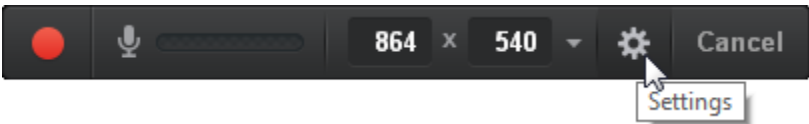
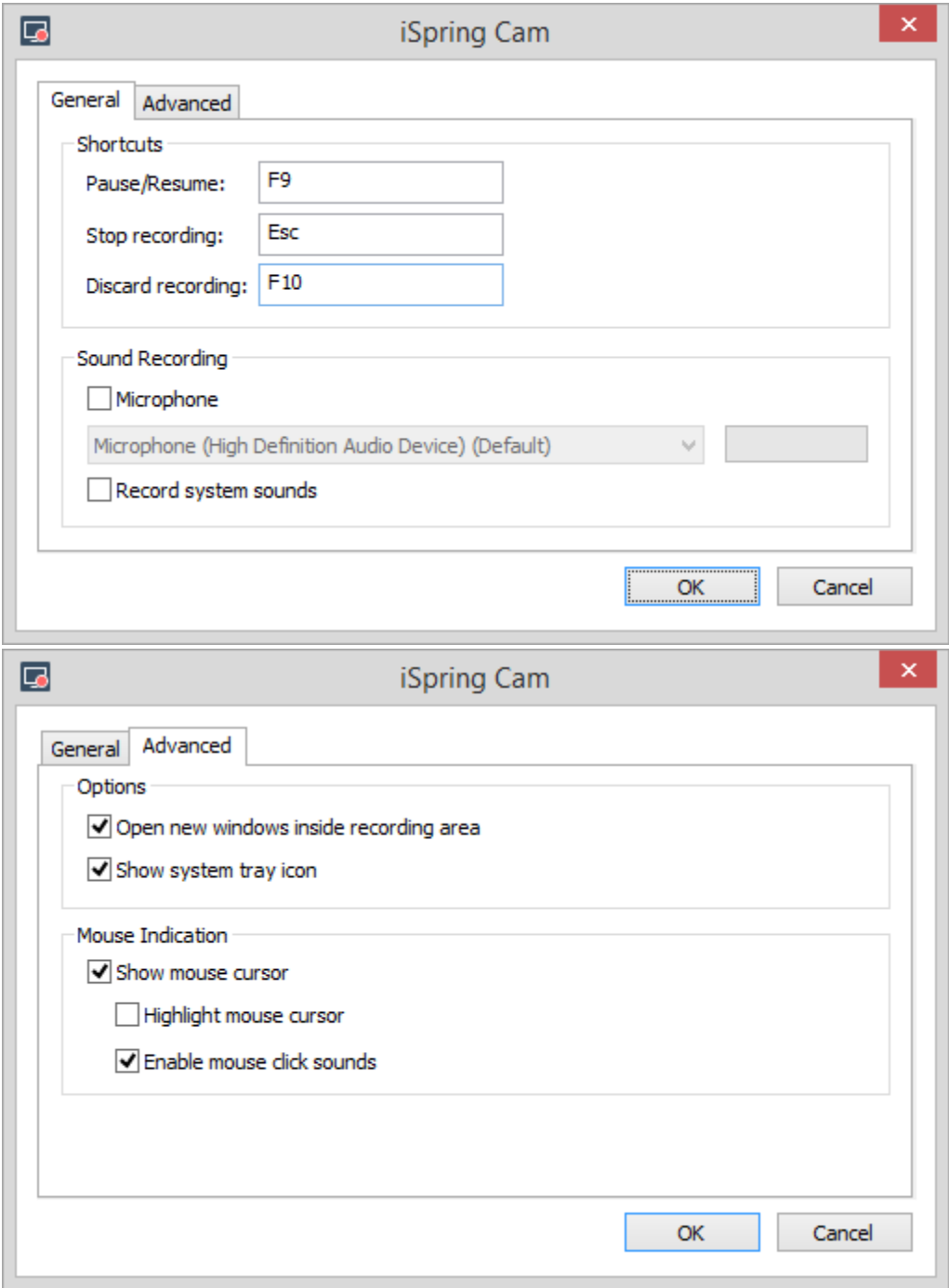


# iSpring Cam Settings


To edit the iSpring Cam Settings, click on the **Settings** icon on the toolbar.



In the Settings window, you can customize the shortcuts, enable sound recording, and change the mouse cursor options.



Option	Description
--------	-------------

<b>Shortcuts</b>	<p>You can assign any custom shortcut key to manage the recording or use the default program shortcuts.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>F9</b> - Pause/Resume recording</li> <li>• <b>Esc</b> - Stop recording</li> <li>• <b>F10</b> - Cancel recording</li> </ul>
<b>Microphone</b>	If you want to record sound from your microphone, select the <b>Microphone</b> checkbox.
<b>Record system sounds</b>	If you want to record system sounds from your computer, select the <b>Record system sounds</b> checkbox.
<b>Open new windows into recording area</b>	All new windows will open inside the recording area. It is useful if you demonstrate a software that includes multiple windows or use multiple monitors.
<b>Show system tray icon</b>	If you check this option, the iSpring Cam icon will be displayed in your system tray while you are recording.
<b>Show mouse cursor</b>	You can check this option if you want the mouse cursor to be displayed in your screen recordings.
<b>Highlight mouse cursor</b>	<p>You can turn it on to highlight the mouse cursor.</p> 
<b>Enable mouse click sounds</b>	You can turn it on and off to enable or eliminate the mouse clicking sound while recording your screen.
