You can set up any name and URL for your iSpring Learn account and add alternative domain names.

## Changing Account Name

1. Open the **Settings** tab in the main menu and click the **Main** tab.
2. Type a new name for your account in the **Account Name** field.
3. Click the **Save** button.

## Changing Account URL


1. Open the **Settings** tab in the main menu and click the **Main** tab.
2. Type a new URL for your account in the **Account URL** field.
3. All account users will be automatically notified about the URL change. If you don't want them to receive email alerts, untick **Notify all users about changes**.

4. Click the **Save** button.

5. Once you apply the changes, you will see a notification that your account URL has been changed. A few seconds later, you will be automatically redirected to the new URL, where you will have to log in again.

 Changing the account URL will require that all the publishers change their publishing settings in iSpring products (iSpring Suite, iSpring QuizMaker, iSpring Visuals, iSpring TalkMaster).

 The URLs of all the materials will be changed in accordance with the new account URL.

## Domain Aliasing

You can add domain aliases to your iSpring Learn account. To do this, contact [iSpring Learn Tech Support](#).

### Account Name

Changing your Account URL will require all the publishers to change their publish settings in iSpring products. It will automatically replace the iSpring Learn publishers login URL. Your content items will be preserved, but their links will be changed according to your new Account URL.
