# **Updating a Group**

You can update a group by sending the POST request to the following URL: /group/<group\_id>.

Permission to run the request: Account Owner, Administrator, Organization Administrator.

#### Request Headers

Parameter	Description
X-Auth-Account-Url (required)	Base URL of the account, e.g. http://myaccount.ispringlearn.com
X-Auth-Email (required)	Administrator e-mail address.
X-Auth-Password (required)	Administrator password.
X-Name (required)	A name of the specified group.
X-Description (optional)	A description of the specified group.
X-Users (optional)	comma-separated list of user IDs to be added to the group.

After the request has been completed, the system returns the response with Code 200. The body of the response may contain the X-Excess-Users header with a comma-separated list of user IDs, who were not added to the group.

### Possible Response Codes

Code	Text	Description
404	Unknown group	The group with the specified name was not found.
403	Permission denied	You have no permission to edit the group info.
400	Bad Request	The system failed to process the request, because it did not contain all necessary parameters.
403	A group with a given name already exists.	A group with the specified name already exists.
200	Ok	The specified group has been updated.
