


Adding Audio to Feedback

The updated feedback window gives you more editing options. Now, you can add images or equations to your feedback messages and import or record sound.


Recording Audio

1. Open the **Edit Feedback** window.





2. Click **Record** and start reading your narration into the microphone.



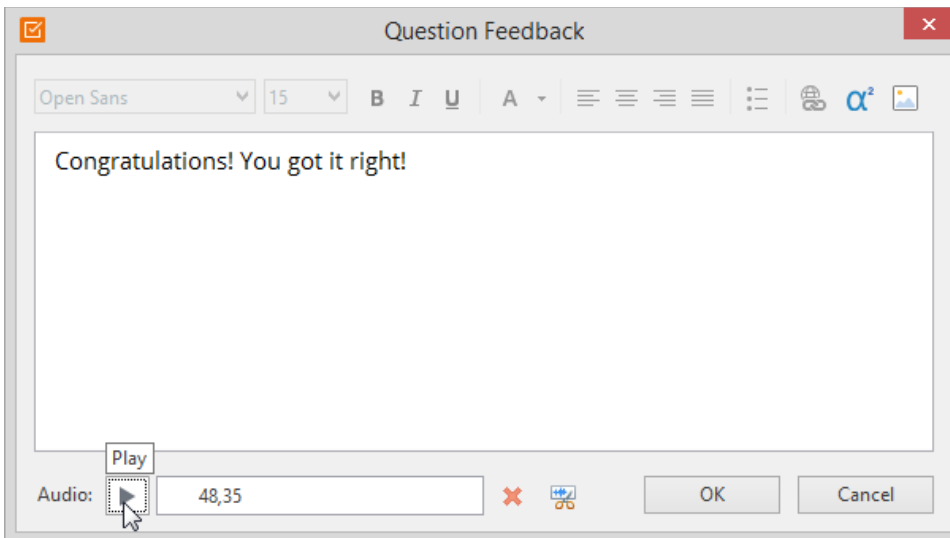

3. Stop recording by clicking the **Stop** button.

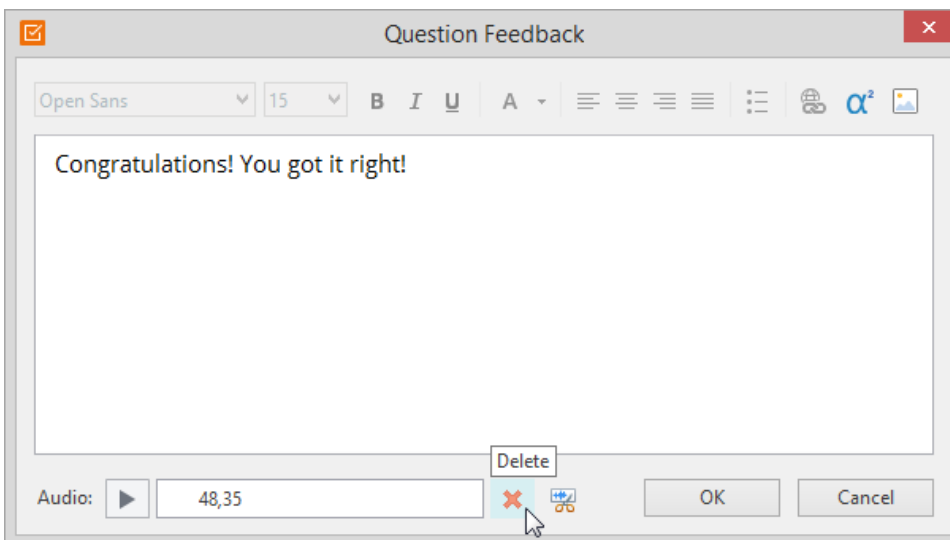

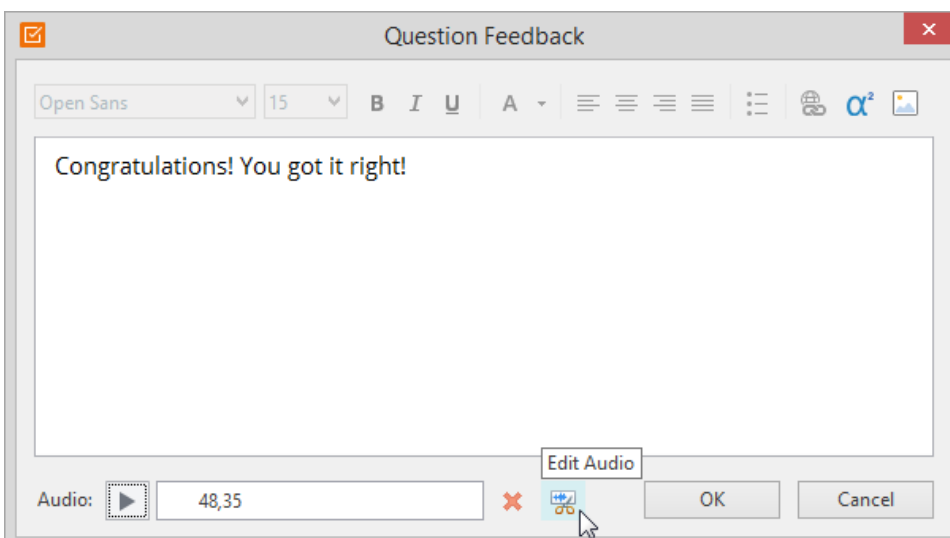
4. You can play the recorded file by clicking the **Play** button.



5. Click the **Delete** button to delete your audio and record another.



6. Click the **Edit Audio** button to open the [iSpring Audio Editor](#) to trim your audio file, silence parts of it, etc.




7. Once you are done editing, click **OK** in the Question Feedback window.

Inserting Audio


To add a new audio file to your question:

1. Open the Edit Feedback window.




