Setting Up the Microphone

Before you start recording new voice-overs and narrations, you can set up your mic. With the new Microphone Setup Wizard, you can verify that your audio is set up correctly. Simply connect the microphone, run the Wizard to set volume and mic sensitivity, and use it to record new voice-overs.

Follow these detailed instructions below to setup your mic:

1. Open the iSpring Cam Settings.



2. Start the Wizard by clicking Set Up Microphone and click Next.


5. Check the recommendations at this step and click Next.

7. If the setup finishes successfully, you will see a notification that your mic was properly configured and now it is ready to use.



8. The setup may fail due to a number of reasons. You will see the error description on the screen. You can click **Back** and repeat recording following the recommendations on the error screen.
