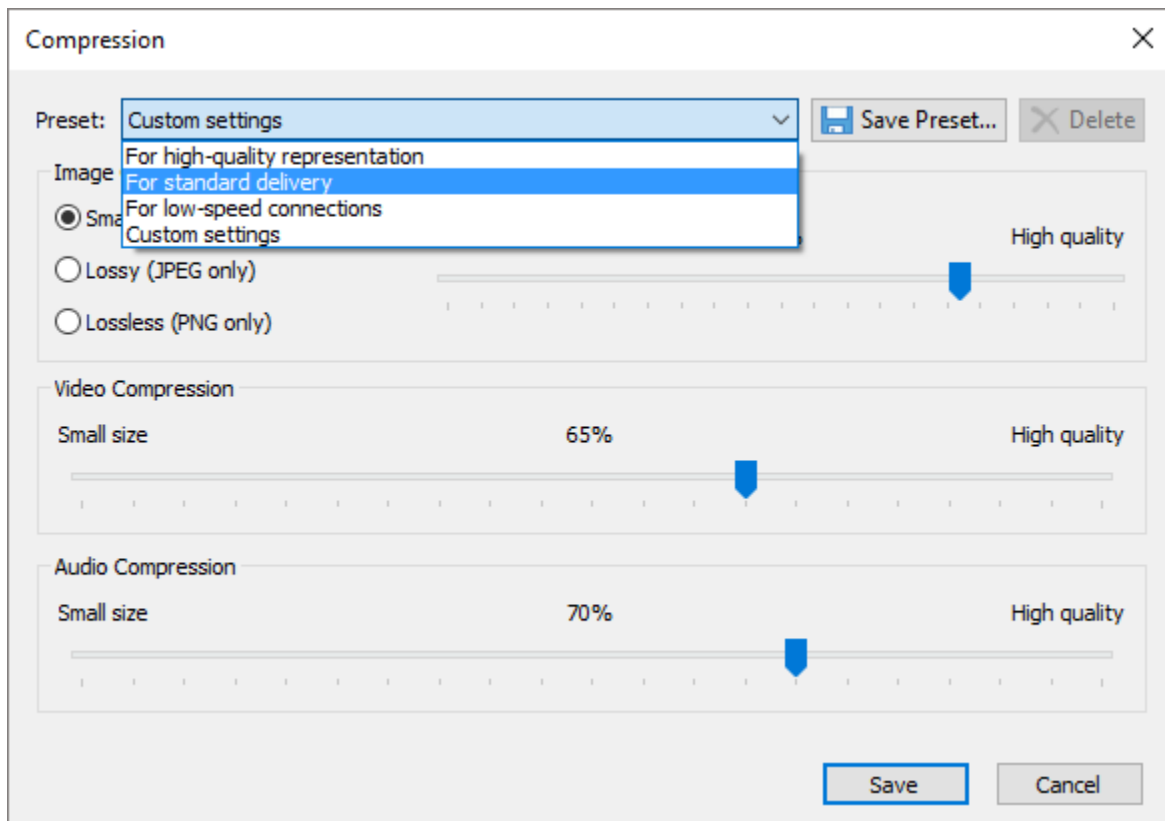

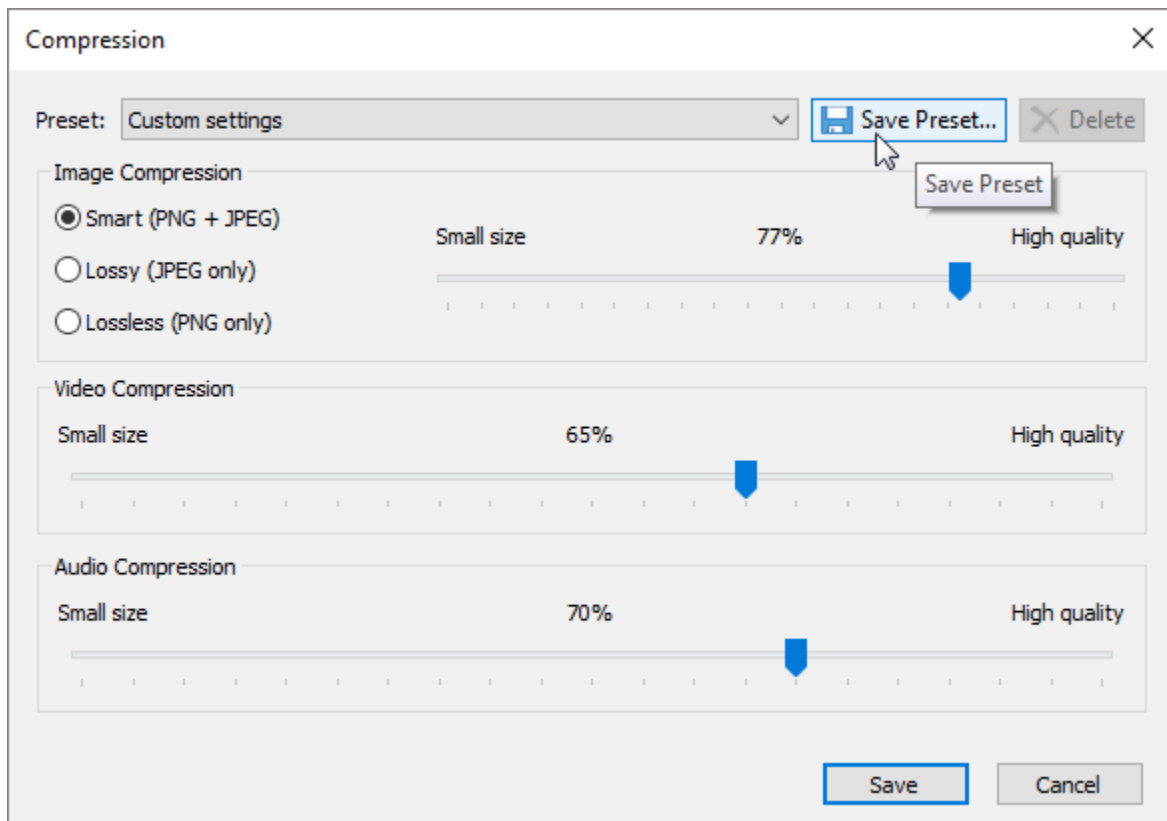

Image Compression	
Image Compression	<p>Smart compression automatically chooses which type of compression to apply to a particular image in the course: lossy or lossless. The result is the most optimal in terms of quality and size.</p> <p>Lossy compression will save all images from the course to .jpg format with the specified compression settings.</p> <p>Lossless saves images to .png format. This will ensure the best quality, but the output files will be large.</p>

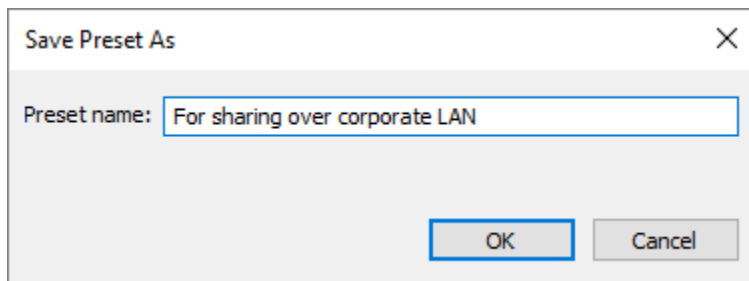
Audio Compression	
Audio Compression	<p>You can set the sound quality in your published course from 0% (low quality and small size) to 100% (high quality and size). The recommended quality is 50% or higher. Note that the higher the audio quality, the larger the final file size.</p> <p>Note: Audio compression settings affect the audio quality of video files as well.</p>

Video Compression	
Video Compression	<p>You can set the video quality in your published course from 0% (low quality and small size) to 100% (high quality and size). The recommended quality is 50% or higher. Note that the higher the video quality, the larger the file size will be.</p>

You can save a custom preset by clicking the **Save Preset** button. To delete a custom preset, click **Delete**.



Enter a name for the profile and click **OK**.



The saved profile will be added to the list of available profiles. You can select it when publishing all the courses on your computer.
