

Managing Media Resources

iSpring QuizMaker 9 allows you to insert images, video and audio on a slide. Images can be edited right on the slide: trimming, aligning on the slide and arranging in relation to other objects, and applying styles, including borders and effects. Video objects can also be aligned on the slide, arranged in relation to other objects, and enhanced with video effects: choosing borders, adding shadows and highlights, and selecting a frame that will be displayed as a thumbnail. iSpring QuizMaker 9 allows you to add ready-made audio files or record your own, and offers a wide range of editing options in the built-in editor: cropping, inserting silence, removing noise, adjusting the volume, and applying fade-in and fade-out effects.

Questions and answers can be enhanced with media: images, audio and video, which will be available to users when viewing quizzes on desktops, laptops, and mobile devices: smartphones and tablets. Media objects can be inserted and edited in **Form View** mode.

Note: Media objects inserted from the Insert tab will not be available to users when viewing quizzes on smartphones, as the quiz player in this case is automatically reconfigured to mobile mode.
